## Anex 1. Modified semi-structured interview script

#### Preamble

## Discovering a diverse identity / Construction of gender identity

- 1) What was your life like before the onset of gender identity?
- 2) What did you feel and think when you did not identify with your biological sex?
- 3) When did you begin (age) to identify as a boy/girl (desired sex)?
- 4) What was that moment of self-revelation like?
- 5) What was the process of revealing your identity to other people like? To whom?

## Transition to the desired gender

- 6) What are the pros and cons of the transition process in relation to the consequences? (medication, process, EPS)
- 7) How has the hormonal transition process been? Did you ever decide to self-hormonize? Why? Consequences?
- 8) How would you describe your life at this time? How have you experienced this process?
- 9) What has been the most difficult part of the transition process (personal, social, hormonal, family)?

### Gender identity

- 10) How has your behavior (gender role) been during and after the acceptance of your identity in society? (social pressure according to heteronormative roles).
- 11) What does this change of role mean to you?
- 12) Finally, what does it mean to you to be a transgender person? What does it mean to have diverse identities?

#### Final

- 13) Is there anything else you consider important and would like to tell us that we haven't yet asked about?
- 14) Do you think what was discussed reflects what you wanted to convey?
- 15) Should it be necessary, ¿can we contact you again?
